Hawaii Pacific University. He is an economist, academic, author, and political commentator. Before
devoting to professorship, Schoolland worked as an economist at the US International Trade

In 1981, Schoolland published his world bestseller **“The Adventures of Jonathan Gullible”**, based
on his series of economic comments aired on the radio in the early 80es. The book so far has been
translated and published into 48 languages, including Bulgarian.
